E-VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1 Apply online Upload Photo and Passport Page
- 2 Pay eVisa fee online Using Credit / Debit card / Payment Wallet
- 3 Receive ETA Online Electronic Travel Authorization ETA Will be sent to your e-mail
- 4 Fly To India Print ETA and present at Immigration Check Post where eVisa will be stamped on passport.

Advisory
Government of India makes no provision of charging of any emergency fees or additional fees for grant of any emergency / express e-visa. Those travelling to India are also advised to go through instructions available on the website of Bureau of Immigration at <https://boi.gov.in>.
eVisa is admissible only under the following categories:

1. e-Tourist Visa
2. e-Business Visa
3. e-Conference Visa
4. e-Medical Visa
5. e-Medical Attendent Visa
6. e-Emergency X-Misc Visa

If the applicant is unable to complete his e-visa application form, he may save the application and may return to complete the application form by clicking the tab at the bottom of page:

After your eVisa applications is submitted, the same shall be scrutinized and if any Document/Image is not appropriate, you may be advised on your given e-mail to re-upload the same. To re-upload use the tab at the bottom of the page. Applicant should normally receive this mail within 24 hours.

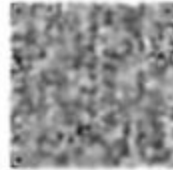

Note :

- Please carry a copy of this ETA in the time of your arrival in India.
- e-Visa is non-transferable, non-conversionable & not valid for visiting Protected/Restricted and Cantonment Areas. If you intend to visit Protected/Restricted/Cantonment areas, you should require prior permission from the Civil Authority. Please visit (<http://www.indianvisaonline.gov.in/content/ivappap-protected/restricted-area-permit/>) for more information.
- Biometric details of the applicant will be mandatorily captured at Immigration on arrival in India.
- Applicant must arrive with the same passport as mentioned above. However, entry may be allowed on the new passport even if ETA has been issued on the old passport, but in that case the traveler must carry the old passport on which ETA was issued.
- Please check all the details including Nationality, Name, Passport number, Date of Birth etc. mentioned on the ETA. If there is any discrepancy, please contact e-Visa support center at indian-eta@gov.in for assistance.
- Applicant can arrive at 28 e-Visa designated airports (i.e. Ahmedabad, Amritsar, Bagdogra, Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Cochin, Chandigarh, Chennai, Coimbatore, Delhi, Gaya, Goa, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Madurai, Mangalore, Mumbai, Nagpur, Port Blair, Pune, Tiruchirappalli, Trivandrum, Varanasi, Vishakhapatnam and 5 designated airports (i.e. Chennai, Cochin, Goa, Mangalore, Mumbai). However, hotels can depart from any of the authorized Immigration Check Posts in India.
- e-Visa is not allowed for employment, NGO activities and journalistic purposes.
- Once you have entered India, you will be subject to Indian Laws.
- This electronic travel authorization does not entitle you for guaranteed entry into India. Your entry can still be refused at the time of arrival.
- Please confirm that your ETA status is shown as "GRANTED" on our Official website (<https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/eta/tracketa.html>) prior to commencement of your journey.
- Applicant must carry YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION CARD if arriving from yellow fever affected countries. Please visit the link given below (<http://www.mohfw.mca.gov.in/index.php?lang=1&level=1&subtabid=1542&lid=1259>)
- **You have paid US \$25 towards Visa Processing Fee. Government of India has not authorized any third party to act as intermediary in issuance of e-Visa. Only 2.5% (3.5% in case of PayPal) bank charges apply.**
